ON BOARD



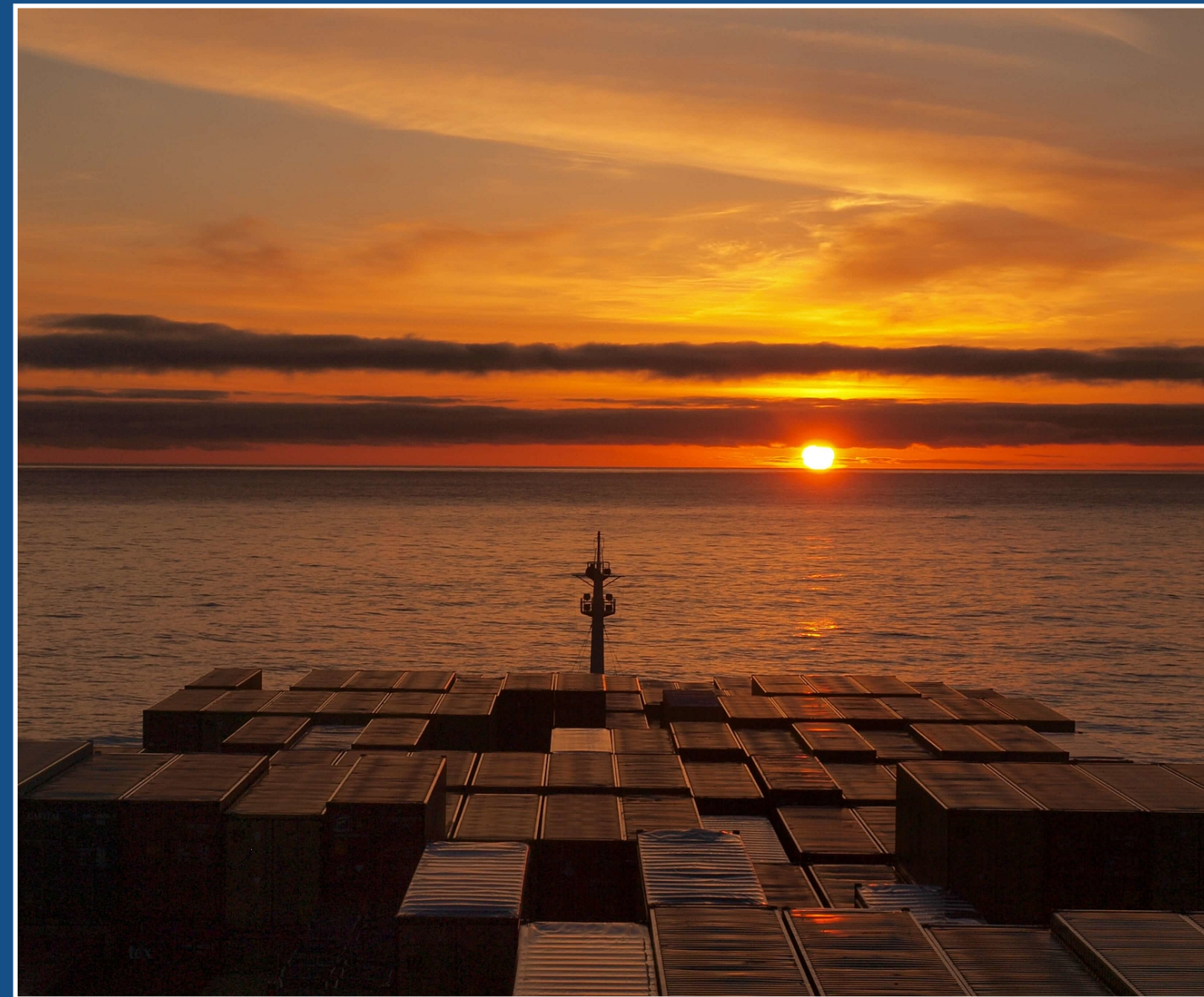

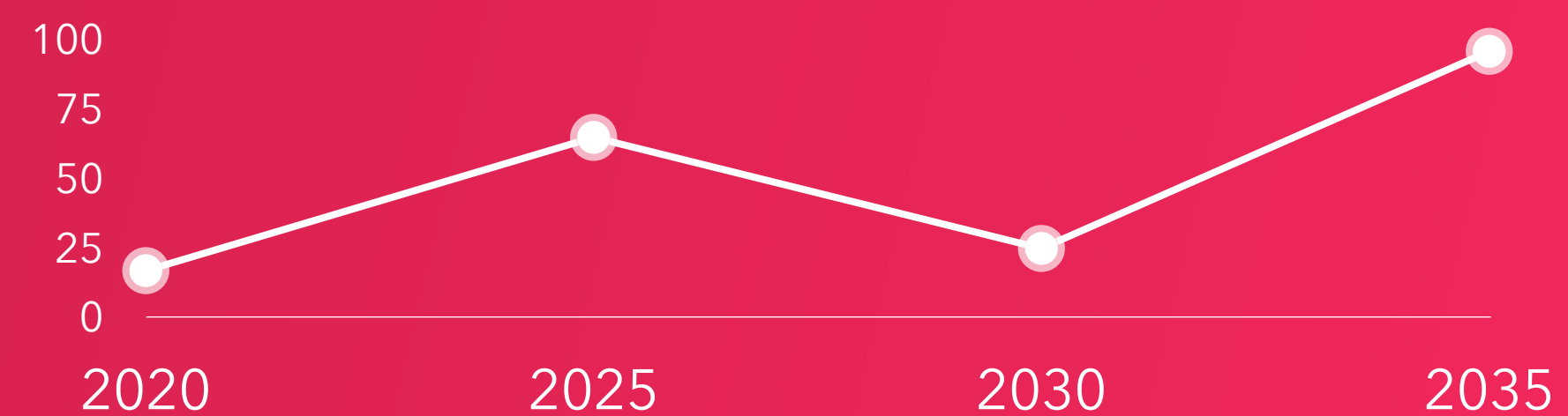

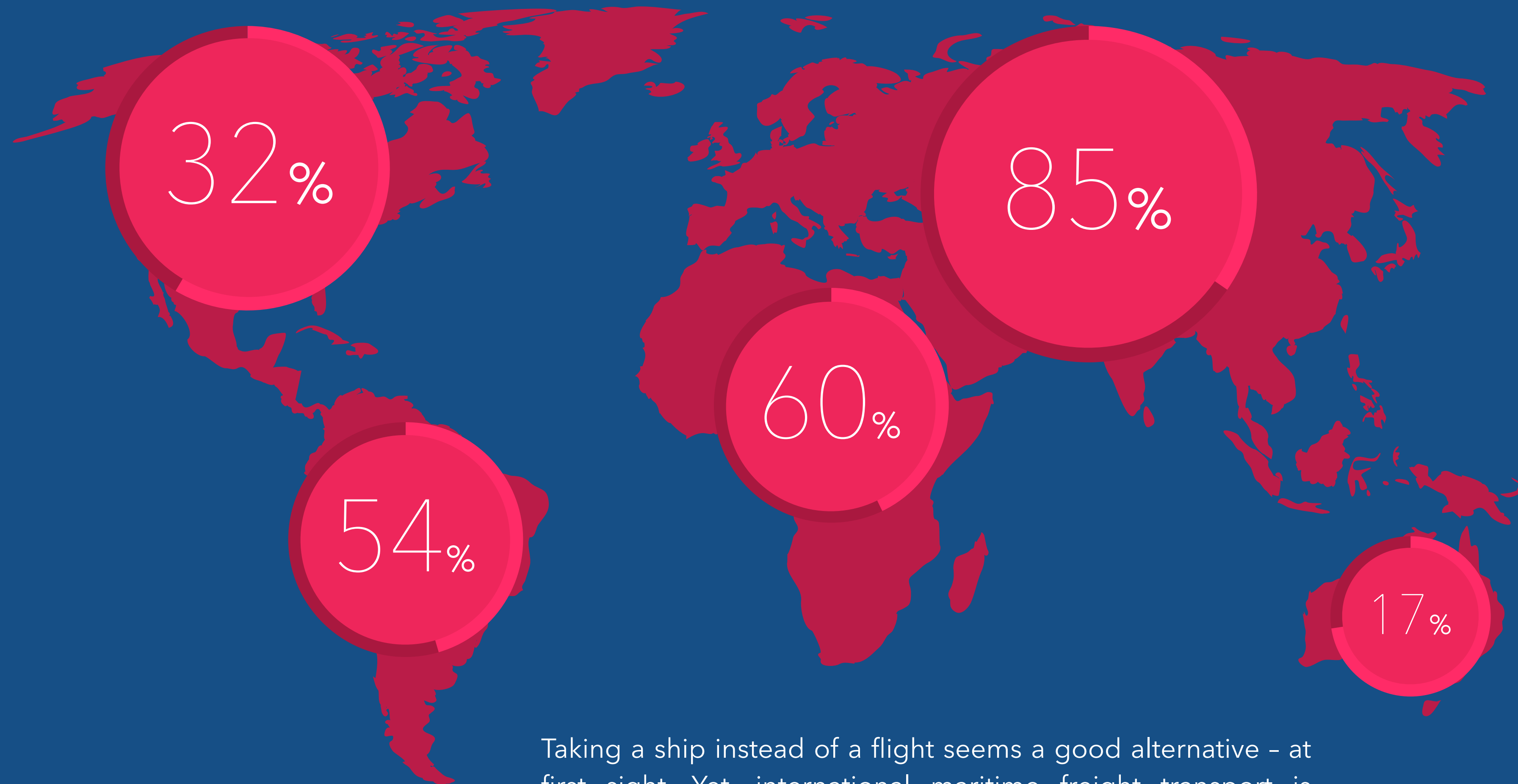
TRAVELING BY CARGO SHIP
